General Requirements		
1. Definitions:		
a. Qualified - persons who have had training in avoiding the electrical hazards of working on or near exposed energized parts.		
b. Unqualified - those lacking sufficient training.		
2. Are workers training in the safety-related work practices required by OSHA regulations (1910.331 through 1910.335) as required by their jobs?		
3. Do all employees with a significant risk of electric shock receive training on safety-related work practices?		
4. Is electrical safety training provided to:		
a. Supervisors?		
b. Electrical engineers and technicians?		
c. Machine operators?		
d. Material handling equipment operators?		
e. Mechanics and repair personnel?		
f. Welders?		
5. Are electricians trained and familiar with the following:		
a. The skills and techniques necessary to determine the voltages of live parts?		
b. Clearance distances required around live parts?		
6. Have all qualified persons received training on and are familiar with the following items:		
a. Skills and techniques necessary to determine the nominal voltage of exposed live parts, and		
b. Proper clearance distances for the appropriate voltages as specified in 1910.333?
