### Other Portable Tools and Equipment Checklist (1910.244)

	O.K.	Action Needed
<b>Jacks</b>		
1. Do operators check to ensure of proper jack rating to lift and sustain the load prior to use?		
2. Are all jacks permanently marked with the proper load?		
3. Are procedures in place to ensure:		
a. Block of the base if done in an area where slippage may occur?		
b. That the load is cribbed or blocked after raising?		
c. All jacks are properly lubricated at regular intervals?		
d. Antifreeze is used in hydraulic jacks?		
e. Jacks are inspected before and after unusual load or shock, after repair, or at least every six months?		
f. That jacks found defective are tagged and removed from service until repairs are made?
